Math Facts Games

If you have dice:

1. **Get to Zero!** – Each person starts with scores of 20. On your turn, roll 1 die and subtract the number from 20. The first person to get to zero wins!
2. **Pig!** – Player 1 rolls two dice and then adds and records the sum of the dice on a piece of paper. Player 2 then rolls the two dice and records their sum. Each player gets 10 total rolls. The catch? If a player rolls a 1, they lose five points! The first player to get to 30 wins!

If you have cards:

Nifty 50 -

Deal all the cards between all the players. Each player turns over four cards and makes a two digit + two digit number sentence or two digit – two digit number sentence that has solution is closest to 50. The equation that is closest to 50 gets one point. IF you can create an equation that is exactly 50, it's worth 2 points. If both players have the same answer, no one gets a point.

During play, Aces are worth 1, and face cards and 10s are worth 0, other cards are face value. After the cards are used, they are put in a discard pile. You can play five rounds with two players in a group, but it can easily be up to four players with two decks of cards.

Students may benefit from having a whiteboard/scrap paper to work out equations before playing their cards.
