Measure how far you were able to jump using a tape measure or a non-standard measurement tool like yarn or shoes! Next throw a ball or Frisbee from the starting point. Measure how far you can throw. Ask family members to join in, who can throw or jump the farthest?

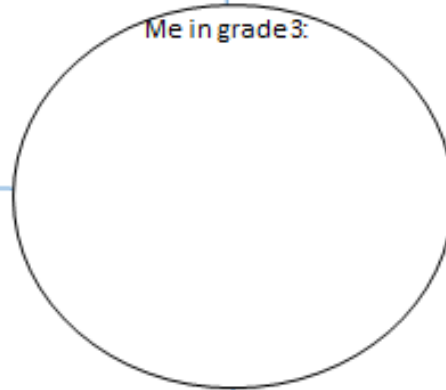
