## Mrs. Richards Problem

Create arrays (rectangles) using 24 shapes or figures. Record the multiplication equation illustrated by the array. Decompose each array to show two other equations that are illustrated by your arrays.

The commutative property of multiplication means the order in which you multiply does not matter. This is sometimes helpful in rearranging the factors to make a calculation "friendlier". The distributive property of multiplication allows students to record partial products.
