Text Structure for Procedural Writing

Purpose: To provide instructions about how to make, do or be something:

<u>Do</u>	<u>How to Make</u>	<u>How to Be a</u>
plant a flower	a garden	good friend
play hopscotch	a kite	soccer player
care for a pet	a bike Ramp	gymnast
go fishing	a birdhouse	good student
fly a kite	a bird Feeder	dancer
skip rope	a sandwich (choose your favourite sandwich)	at home helper at your age
wash a load of laundry	bake cookies/cake	good brother/sister
ride a bike	a bed	good pet owner

Include the following in your procedural writing:

- **Title**
- **Goal** What is going to be made or done?
- **Materials** What is needed?
- **Steps** How will it be made or done? Remember to use transition words as you move from one paragraph to the next.
