




#### French Immersion Program

# How to help your child

- Ask your child to talk about their day.
- Read to your child in English nightly. Enjoy story time together and make it fun!
- Eventually your child will bring home books in French for homework. Even if you don't understand, you can still encourage your child to look at the pictures, make the sounds they see, make predictions, recap what they've read, etc.



#### Homework

 Homework will change throughout the school year. At the beginning, students will practice familiar songs & poems. They will soon know these by heart! ♥ Encourage them to point to the words as they sing along. This is the first step in learning to read in French. ☺
