Duo-tangs: no plastic duo tangs please

4 green

4 purple

4 orange

1 yellow

1 red

1 blue

Purchasing and supplying these exact colours and combinations will help to keep students and classroom centers organized. It will also help your child with organization and independence when switching from one center/activity to another.

3 packs of 4 **Hilroy** scribblers (please, no coiled notebooks or binders)

40 pencils

10 **white** erasers

1 pencil case

1 ruler (see-through rulers are easier for students to use)

2 red pens (please, no gel pens)

2 green pens (please, no gel pens)

16 dry erase markers for at school learning (thick, Expo brand if possible)

1 pack of markers

1 pack of 24 crayons **or** pencil crayons

8 glue sticks

1 pair of scissors

1 package of regular-sized, multi-coloured construction paper

2 box of large Zip-Lock freezer bags for at school learning (please, no slider-zip tops)

1 box of sandwich-sized bags for at school learning (please, no slider-zip tops)

Good quality ear-phones with a microphone (needed 2-3 times/week)

Recorder- the Music teacher recommends the recorders available at the Pawn Shop in Rexton, but anything that is **not** from a Dollar Store will do.

Indoor **sneakers** - non-marking soles, please

English class only:

1 yellow writing folder (a two pocket portfolio, like a duo-tang, but with no prongs and two pockets)
