Register for your free library card on the bookmobile, in any New Brunswick public library or on our website. You just need one piece of identification with your current New Brunswick address. Children under 13 years old need a parent's signature.

Find what you are looking for on our website:

- The most up-to-date bookmobile schedules and cancellations.
- The **library catalogue**, **Vision**, where you can find materials, access your account information, place holds, review items and even keep track of your reading.
- The **Electronic Library** where you can download eBooks and audiobooks onto your computer or electronic device.
- **Electronic resources** for accessing newspaper and magazine articles, language learning tools and Chilton small engine repair guides.
