



<h2 style="color: #0070C0;">Student Attendance Matters!</h2> <p>Dangerous weather conditions and power outages have resulted in the government of New Brunswick having to close schools in our region frequently since December 2016.</p> <p>ASDN Superintendent, Beth Stymiest, has directed schools to compact/integrate curriculum and to optimize our instructional minutes.</p> <p>Parents/guardians of RES students are asked to please work with us to maximize student learning/achievement by ensuring that their children:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ARRIVE on time each school day, REMAIN at school for the entire instructional day (avoid early dismissals). A reminder that our instructional day begins sharply at 8:35 daily. K-2 students are dismissed at 1:55 and grades 3-5 students are dismissed at 3:10. Continue to READ, WRITE, and work on the online MATH REFLEX program at home every day (even on snow days)!

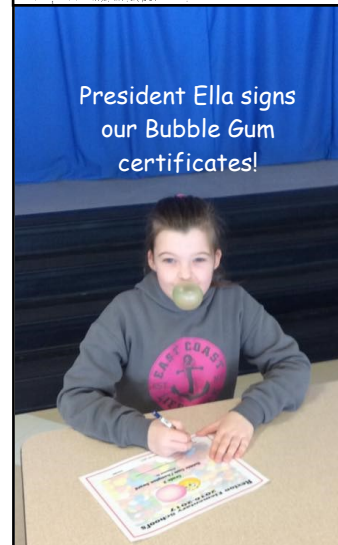

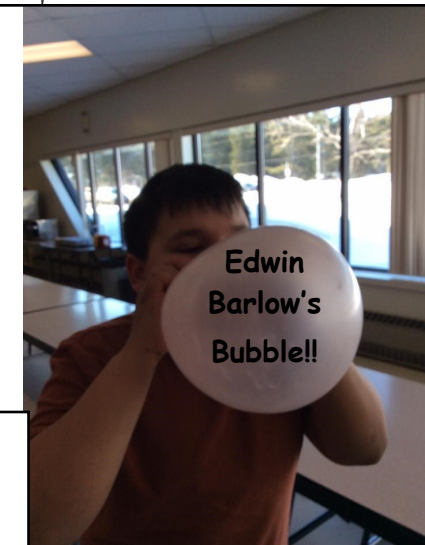
