### RES's Safe & Positive Learning Environment

#### **Bus Safety Reminders:**

- i). There is to be **no** eating or drinking on our school buses.
- ii). Students are expected to talk softly and remain seated when traveling on our school buses; all students are expected to behave in a respectful manner when travelling on the bus.
- iii). Our bus drivers are only permitted to drop-off students at his/her address when they **see the** child's parent/quardian in the child's yard or drop-off zone.
- iv). Anglophone North School District schools (including Rexton Elementary School) DO NOT grant bus transfers. Our first priority is the safety of ALL of our students. Attempting to arrange bus transfers, for convenience sake, compromises the safety of all of students and dramatically interrupts our safe and orderly dismissal procedures. Instead of writing a note asking for a bus transfer, parents are expected to contact a family member or neighbour to make arrangements for them to meet their child when he/she arrives home.

#### School Parking & Drop-Off Zones:

To ensure the safety of our students, all visitors and parents to Rexton Elementary are reminded to:

- i). Use the clearly identified entrance/exit AND DRIVE SLOWLY when driving in and out of our school yard.
- ii). Ensure that their child gets out of their vehicle on the drivers-side of the vehicle (onto the sidewalk).
- iii). REMEMBER that only school buses are permitted to park in our School Bus
- iv). DO NOT park or linger in our Drop-off zone or Handicapped Parking Zone (before OR after school).
- v). Parents/visitors are expected to PARK their vehicles in our parking lot if they require more time with their child when dropping-off or picking him/her up at our school.
- vi). A reminder that there is to be <u>no smoking</u> on our school grounds, including in our parking lot AND no dogs are to be brought onto our school premises (some students are allergic or fearful of

#### Dropping Off & Picking-Up Your Child:

- i). Supervision begins at 8:00 a.m.
- ii). Parents are asked to ensure that their child attends school for the entire instructional day, every school day.
- ii). Please write a note to the teacher in your child's Student Agenda when/if you need to pick-up your child at the end of the day.



#### Visitors to RES Must:

- . Seek permission to enter our building by speaking to one of our school's administrators via the security camera microphone.
- ). Sign-in at the office (on the "adult" Sign-In sheet) and then obtain a visitor's pass before entering into our school hallways.
- i). If you are picking-up your child before dismissal, we need you to sign-out your child on the Sign-Out sheet located at the office window.

RES has purchased a license to use the online Math program, REFLEX, for the 2017-2018 school year! Students in grades 2-5 work on this program twice a week during the instructional day to increase their instant recall of their addition, subtraction, multiplication, and/or division facts.

- Teachers monitor their student's progress with this program online.
- Parents are encouraged to have their child work on the Reflex program on their family's home computer as much as possible.
- Students know their Reflex password but if parents want to track their child's progress, please refer to the Reflex letter that was sent home or contact your child's teacher.
- Parents will be able to speak to their child's teacher about how their child performed on our recent K-2 Key Math Skills assessment or Grades 3-5 June 2017 Math assessment during the upcoming Parent/Teacher meetings which will be held on November 23rd or 24th.
- Parents of Kindergartners could work on the following concepts with their child: i). before/after, ii). one more/less, and iii). counting forwards from 0-10 and backwards from 10-0.
- Parents of Grade 1 students could work on the following concepts with their child: i). before & after, ii). two more/less, and iii). counting forward from 0-20 and backwards from 20-0.
