RES's 2017 STEAM Exhibit

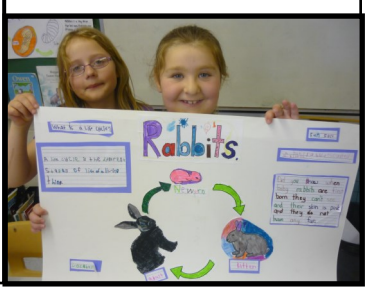
