

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"DO THE MATH" Parent Info Corner: ATTENTION We need <u>YOU</u>, the parents/guardians of our students, to help us improve our children's mental math skills!

How Can YOU Help?

- 1. Drill your child DAILY on his/her addition & subtraction, and/or multiplication & division facts.
- 2. Make FLASH CARDS OR purchase FLASH CARDS at the Rexton Canadian Dollar Store and help your child practice his/her facts!
- 3. Work with your child in using strategies to solve adding/subtracting, multiplying and/or dividing problems (see your child's Math Duo-tang for the strategies your teacher has provided).
- 4. Install the wildly popular and totally free online Math Facts program entitled: Timez Attack on your home computer and encourage your child work on this program daily; have your child set a goal to master their grade applicable level. For example, Grade 2 students are expected to reach LEVEL 23 by the end of year).

Home Use

Downloading Timez Attack:

1. Go to http://bigbrainz.com/Implementation.php and select Windows or Mac.



2. After it downloads, click on the Timez Attack icon on your desktop

3. Select your student's Province, District, and School.

Your student's password is: Rexton1



4. Select the student's class. Then click on the student's ID, which begins with the first 2 letters of their first and last name.


