"Oh, Baby it's Cold Outside" ...



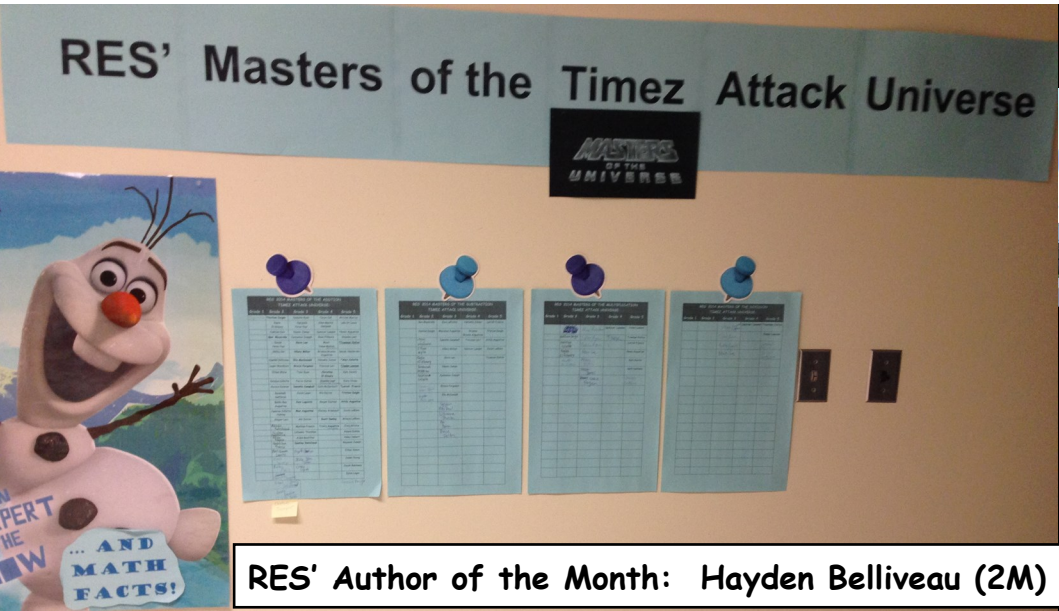

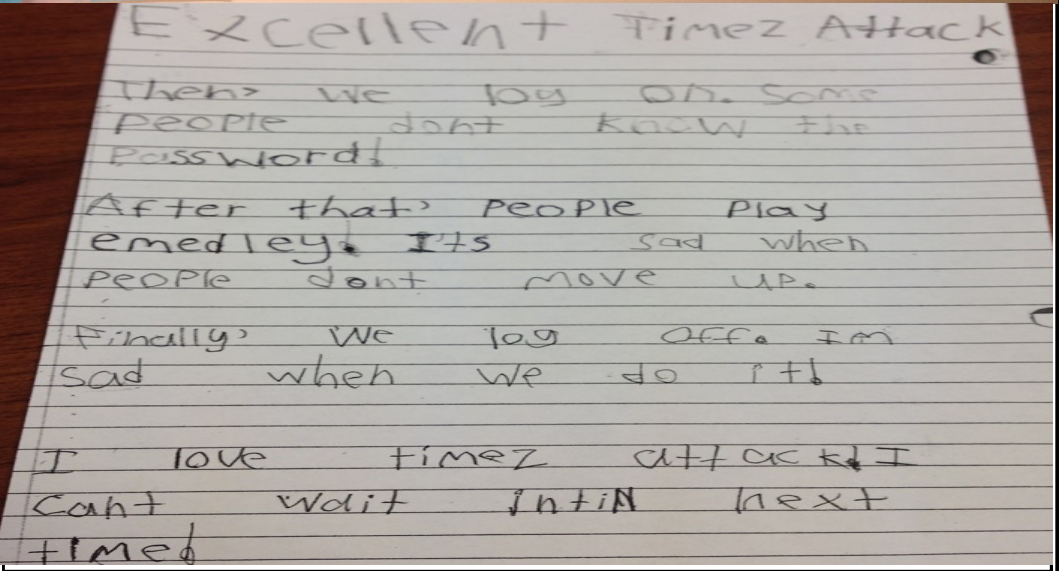
