



FREE Government Money for Your Child's Education

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Families whose child was born in or after 2004, and whose family income is below \$45,000, are able to receive up to \$2000 free from the Government of Canada to pay for their children's education!



Parents only have to subscribe to a registered education savings plan (RESP). No contribution to the Plan is required to be able to receive government assistance. When you subscribe to an RESP, the Government of Canada shall immediately deposit \$500 (and may deposit up to \$1,500 to your child's Plan) up to the age of 15 years.
