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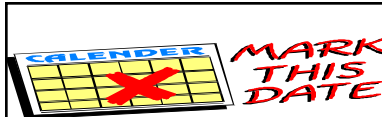
RES' 2016 On My Way to K

RES' 2016 Heritage Week

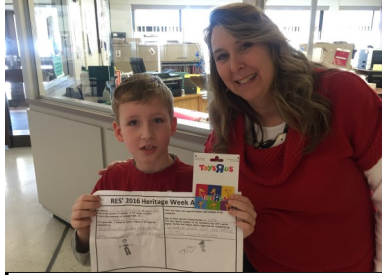
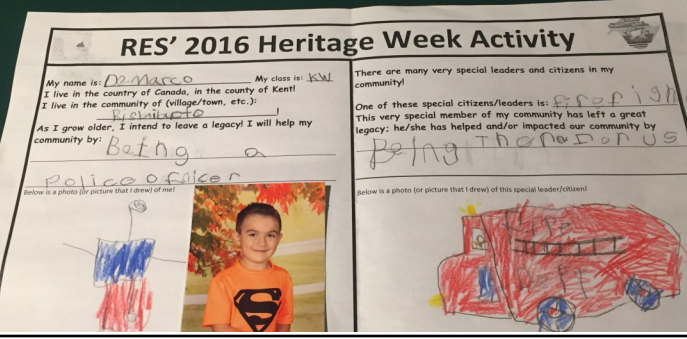
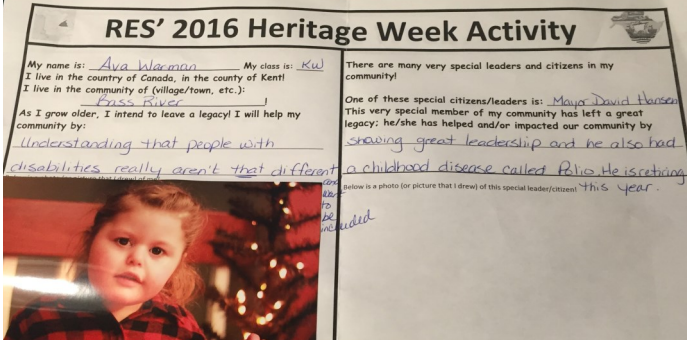
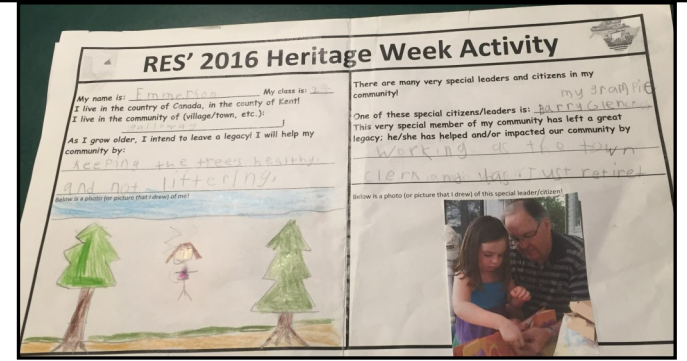
This year's Heritage Week was held from February 8th-15th. This year's theme was **Leadership & Legacy**.

On Wednesday, Feb. 10th the students created valentines for our seniors and veterans who live at the Rexton Lions Nursing Home.

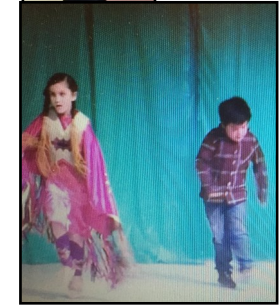
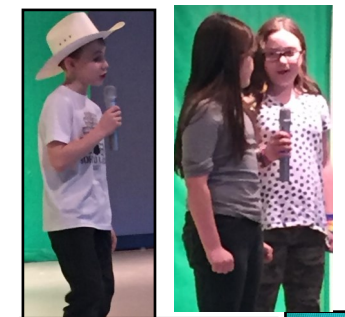
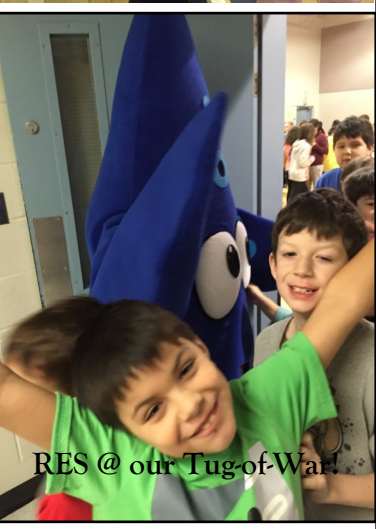
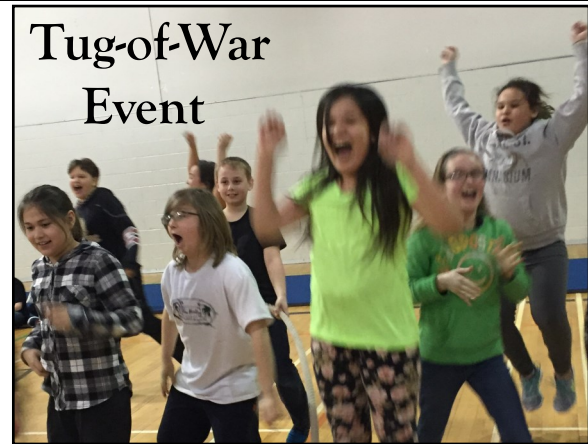
On Thursday, Feb. 11th. RES' students & staff enjoyed the TNB production of, "The Space Between).
